In light of POPIA taking effect on 1 July 2021, we want to ensure our community understands the context of the ACT and how Sector 8 complies with POPIA.

POPIA stands for the Protection of Personal Information Act – the South African data privacy and data protection law that was enacted in 2013 and will come into effect 1 July 2021. The full act can be viewed and downloaded from the site: <https://www.gov.za/>

In summary; The Act applies to any person or organisation who keeps any type of records relating to the personal information of anyone, this includes CPF Sector 8. It sets some conditions for responsible parties to lawfully process the personal information of data subjects (our members).

Personal information, includes first name, last name, state-issued ID number, financial account number, credit or debit card number, and any other personal identifiable information.

Some of this information is collected as part of our membership application, in order to know who our members are, and be in a position to communicate with our members using the method elected on the application form. Our data is stored in a secure system, not accessible to any member of the public and will not be shared with anyone whatsoever.
